Members of the Mountville Fire Company No. 1, Municipal Officials & Residents,

The Mountville Fire Company No. 1 proudly answered 366 requests for assistance in 2024. It is because of great support from the municipalities and residents that we serve that we have continued to offer 100% volunteer fire service to our area for over 100 years. We are proud of our continued service to Mountville Boro, West Hempfield Township and beyond.

The department currently has 30 responding firefighters, and while that may seem like plenty, due to family time, work schedules, and other commitments the company only averages 5 firefighters per incident. In 2024 only 6 members responded to more than 25% of the calls, which illustrates that emergencies are handled by a core group of firefighters. Our top responder responded to 69% of the calls, which is a significant commitment to our fire company. While some firefighters are unable to respond to a high volume of calls, their sacrifice does not go unnoticed and can prove to be valuable to our organization and to the citizens we serve.

The statistics above and throughout this report are similar to 2023. One major change is the decrease in average personnel per incident. This means less members answer emergency calls. We continue to provide volunteer emergency services to Mountville Borough, West Hempfield Township, and surrounding areas, but with fewer firefighters per incident. While other local fire companies have begun supplementing with paid staffing, Mountville Fire Company has not. The fire company has added additional firefighters during 2024, unfortunately, they have only replaced firefighters who have stopped answering calls and not increased our total staff.

In 2024, Mountville Fire Company No. 1 responded to eight first due incidents (five Mountville Borough, three West Hempfield Township) where active fire endangered a total of \$1.8 million (pre-incident property value). Due to the efforts of Mountville Fire Company #1 and mutual aid companies, the total loss was limited to \$417,500. This equates to 77% property saved (\$1,409,150). Unfortunately, in a March fire, under heavy fire conditions, firefighters located and removed a resident from a house fire on Froelich Avenue, however, the resident did not survive.

Mountville Fire Company No. 1 continues to provide air supply support for working fires for the entire western part of Lancaster County and beyond. Those calls totaled 33 this past year, filling a total of 768 cylinders. In addition to emergency air support calls, Mountville Fire Company No. 1 refilled other stations air filling systems 11 times.

Public education and fire safety is another service provided by Mountville Fire Company No. 1. A total of ten events connected our members with the community, including over 840 adults and children. Our safety professionals provided observations for three licensed care facilities in our first due area. Additionally, our members planned and executed community events such as the Mountville Days Carnival and Cookies with Santa where the fire company positively interacted with thousands of members within our community.

Our hours of service donated are as follows: 1,064 on incidents, 952 training, and 2,594 for all other activities needed to operate the fire company throughout the year. Combined, these equal 4,612 hours given to our community. As always, this official number is under documented from the actual hours needed to operate. We hope that the municipalities and citizens we serve are aware and value the service of our volunteers.

As I conclude my 21st Year End Report, I cannot express enough gratitude to the members of the Mountville Fire Company No.1 for the efforts and professionalism you show. I am extremely proud to be associated with this membership and honored that you allow me to be the Fire Chief. Thank You.
